

DON RAMON OAK AGED RED

ALCOHOL: 13.5 % Vol.

GRAPE VARIETIES: 75% Garnacha and 25% Tempranillo.

DATE HARVESTED

From the 2nd week of September.

PROCESS

Traditional wine making for both varieties followed by a 10 day maceration with skin contact. After the malolactic fermentation both varieties are blended.

CRIANZA

Ageing for 4 months in American oak barrels being matured in the bottle before sale.

TASTING

Colour: Clean and bright; ruby red with violet tones.

Aroma: Medium intensity, complex aromas combining matured fruity notes with spices and balsamic hints from its aging

Palate: Soft and well structured attack, harmonic with tannins from the oak; long lasting aftertaste.

SERVE: 16° C
