Unique french grapes in a unique Calatayud mountain terroir

Varieties: 90% Petit Verdot, 10% Tannat

Alcoholic content: 14,5%

Vineyard : 800/950 Meter

Oak: 12 months in French oak (30 % new oak)

Colour: Dense red with purple tints. Nose: Intense and quite spicy nose of ripe blackberry fruit with a touch of leather.

Palate: Still slightly smoky from the oak, but the vigourous and lifted fruit soon dominate and the firm natural tannins blend in as well.

Food pairing: Red meats, poultry, stews and cheeses.



JAMES SUCKLING: 90 PTS

Aromas of dark plums, dried fruit, tar, baking spices and toasted oak. Full-bodied with firm tannins and a round mouth-feel. Rich and intense with bright acidity and blueberry-jam notes and a long, warming finish. 90% petit verdot and tannat. Drink or hold.
