Our History

Bodem, meaning "soil" in Dutch, truly symbolizes the origin of this winery raised and funded by the family Geirnaerd-van Ekeris. After more than 25 years living and working for Spanish wine, the Dutch family finally found in Cariñena the place where they really feel connected to. That's why this is not only a winery but a firm commitment to Spanish wine, to the Garnacha grape and ultimately, to a dream.

Why Cariñena?

Marga slopes in "Sierra de Algairén". Wild, arid and eroded soils where the elegant Garnacha finds out its petite paradise. Garnacha's grown in Cariñena even before the 3rd century B.C. It is the great unknown outside Spain; the forgotten cradle and birth place of Garnacha grape.

Vineyard

- Bio control and hand cultivation
- Family vineyards owned by local vinegrowers
- Selected vineyards in Sierra de Algairén
- Avg. altitude between 450 and 725 metres
- Deep chalky clay soils, controlled yields, always under 5,000 kg /Ha

Vinification

- Hand harvested in the early cool morning and transported to the winery in small crates (10 kg).
- Cold maceration and fermentation at low temperature.
- Aged on lees for 4 months.
 - 75% in stainless steel.
 - 25% in 500 litre oak barrels.

Winemaker's notes

On the nose, white pulp fruits, lime, mango, together with mountain herbs such as thyme and fennel give it a great complexity. Smooth, enveloping, with weight. It offers a fruity explosion with a lively acidity and mineral touches. A very gastronomic wine.

Service suggestions

Serve at 7-9°C. A perfect partner for couscous with curried vegetables, salmon tartare with avocado or vegetable aubergine moussaka. Grilled white meats create an excellent combination with this energetic Garnacha blanca. Taste it to discover the most authentic profiles of pleasure.
