Bodem Bodegas

Bodem, meaning "soil" in Dutch, truly symbolizes the origin of this winery raised and funded by the family Geirnaerd-van Ekeris. After more than 25 years living and working for Spanish wine, the Dutch family finally found in Cariñena the place where they really feel connected to. That's why this is not only a winery but a firm commitment to Spanish wine, to the Garnacha grape and ultimately, to a dream.

Why Cariñena?

Birth place Garnacha grape. Romans brought the grape in the region of Cariñena. Bodem Bodegas aims to produce the most excellent Garnacha wines of the region. The founders of the Bodem Bodegas Louis Geirnaerd and Eugenie van Ekeris fell in love with Spain and the Garnacha grape more than 28 years ago. This project is their dream come through.

Vineyard

Blending of grape varieties coming from our Sierra de Algairén vineyards, located at one of the highest altitude areas within D.O. Cariñena.

Vinification

Grape varieties are fermented separately enabling us to draw up every single grape variety's character. After malolactic fermentation they go into French and American oak barrels with M+ toasting degree, remaining there 2 months. During the spring we carry out the blending process in stainless steel tanks, where the blend (different varieties coming from different barrels) remains 2 months before being bottled.

Winemaker's notes

Very Intense colour. Dark concentrated fruit and intense maturity together with toasted notes of cocoa and coffee. On the palate nice structure with a touch of tannins. Again we find the tones of black fruit of the forest and toffee. Full bodied with an extraordinary finish.

Service suggestions

Serve at 13-15°C. Oxe is your perfect after-work reward! Enjoy it with cheeses, charcuterie, lamb and ribs. Perfect companion of vegan protein-based dishes such as tofu, quinoa or beans.
